Part-time fees

Note that part time students will pay the fees shown for each year of their study. This amount is not subject to a yearly increase. This does not apply to situations where a student has extended their study beyond the normal duration of the course.

Instalments

For students following the normal academic year, the annual fee may be paid in three equal instalments: the first on registering, the second on the last working day of January and the third on the last working day of March.

School of Informatics Scholarships

The School of Informatics offers a number of scholarships of £2,000 for both home and overseas well-qualified applicants, on our full-time one year postgraduate courses. The scholarships are intended to assist students to pay the fees for their chosen course of study. They will be awarded on a competitive basis focusing on academic merit.

AHRC Professional Preparation Master's Scheme Awards

Well-qualified applicants on the MSc Information Science, the MA/MSc Library and Information Studies, and the MSc Information Management may be eligible for a full maintenance and fees award or a fees-only award, depending on which criteria they meet.

The Alex McVitty Memorial Award

The Memorial Award provides financial assistance of £1,500 towards living expenses. One award each year is offered to a full time home or overseas applicant on the MSc Information Science or the MA/MSc Library and Information Studies who wishes to develop a career in law librarianship and can demonstrate financial need.

Sir John Cass Foundation Scholarships

The Sir John Cass Foundation awards a number of scholarships to applicants undertaking masters programmes at City. The scholarships range between £1,000 and £10,000. They cover tuition fees and may also provide a bursary for living costs, dependent on individual need. Applicants must be a long-term resident of Inner London (over three years) under the age of 25, in possession of an undergraduate degree at upper second or above and able to demonstrate clear financial need.
